

RECRUITMENT ANNOUNCEMENT

The County of Surry is accepting applications for a **Building Codes Inspector** to work in the Surry County Inspections Department of Surry County Development Services. An employee in this position performs skilled inspection work in the enforcement of State and local building codes governing one or more of the following areas of the building trades: electrical, building (construction and energy), mechanical, and plumbing. Work involves inspections of construction of new buildings and the repair of existing buildings for conformance with safety standards, codes, and ordinances; interpretation, application, and enforcement of rules and regulations; checking plans and specifications for compliance; issuing certificates for approved installation; working with contractors, property owners, and the general public; and other duties as required. Work is performed under the supervision of the Development Services Director and is evaluated on the basis of the employee's ability to apply technical knowledge and skills in maintaining inspection standards.

Job Requirements: High school graduation and considerable knowledge and experience in building construction, materials, and practices of the building trades. Experience in residential and/or commercial electrical, building, mechanical, or plumbing construction work is desired. Must obtain prequalification from Department of Insurance (<https://apps.ncdoi.net/f?p=114:1:0>) (**MUST TYPE ADDRESS INTO YOUR BROWSER**) and submit with County of Surry employment application. The selected employee must obtain a standard level I or higher in all areas – building, electrical, plumbing, and mechanical within three years. Additional requirements are the ability to detect defective workmanship in building construction and repair; the ability to interpret blueprints, specifications, codes, and building regulations; considerable knowledge of State and local ordinances and codes; and working knowledge of County geography. Applicants must have a valid driver's license and be insurable under the County's automobile insurance at regular rates. Applicants must be able to meet the physical requirements of the job as outlined in the job description. Good communications skills and public relations skills are desired.
